“LUCK OF THE DRAW” HDCP. BOWLING TOURNAMENT RULES

YOUR HANDICAP WILL BE DETERMINED AT THE END OF EACH EVENT – NO AVG. NEEDED

1. You must be a member of the FOE Auxiliary and present your Official Receipt at check-in.
2. Choice of dates and times will be given in the order that they are received and fees are paid. No telephone or email reservations will be accepted. No entry will be accepted without full payment of all fees. Submit one check per team. There will be no refunds given two weeks prior to the tournament.
3. Substitutions:
 - (a) If a SCHEDULED bowler is unable to bowl, a substitute will be allowed. NO entry fees will be refunded. Substitute must be an Auxiliary member and present her Official Receipt at check-in. The Substitute will not be responsible for any entry fees previously paid. It should be determined between the substitute and the team as to how the prize money, if any, will be divided. Advise the chairman of such.
 - (b) If a team captain contacts the chairman before sending in the entry form or fees, stating they want to bowl in the tournament, but do not have a full team or doubles partners, every attempt will be made to fill the position(s). The “fill-in” would be responsible for all entry fees and would share in any prize money. NOTIFY THE CHAIRMAN ASAP REGARDING ALL SUBSTITUTIONS.
4. Handicap will be determined at the end of each scheduled event. One card (Ace, Two, or Three) will be drawn. This card will determine which of the three games that you bowled that your handicap would be based on. For example, if a 3 is drawn, whatever you bowled in your third game will determine your handicap for all 3 games in that event. Handicap will be 90% of 210 with no limit. Your Handicap will change in each event.
5. It is each bowler's responsibility to verify their score. If there are any discrepancies the State Chairman must be notified within seven (7) days. After that time, no changes can be made.
6. All bowlers must bowl in the order they are listed. No changes or exceptions. A bowler may participate once in Doubles & Singles. You may participate twice in Team Event if there are at least 2 different bowlers on each Team. Your first Team Event will be the one that applies to your All Event Total.
